

# OSAP PERFORMANCE INDICATORS

At Cambrian College, we recognize that student success is subject to a multitude of factors, many beyond the control of the College. While the data in this section is posted in compliance with Ministry directive, we believe that performance indicators are invaluable in helping us understand those factors so that we may improve our service to students.

A few Ministry definitions:

## **CANADA-ONTARIO INTEGRATED STUDENT LOAN (COISL) DEFAULT RATE**

The percentage of 2011-2012 Canada-Ontario Integrated Student Loan (COISL) recipients who did not receive 2012-2013 OSAP funding (loan/grant) and were in default of their COISL repayment obligations as of July 2014.

## **GRADUATE EMPLOYMENT RATE**

The percentage of college graduates in the labour force who were employed.

## **GRADUATION RATE**

The number of students who graduated within approximately 200 per cent of their program's regular duration (or seven years, for students enrolled in a Baccalaureate Degree in Applied Area of Study program), shown as a percentage of program entrants.

## **APPROVED PROGRAM SEQUENCE CODE (APS)**

The APS code is a unique number assigned for each approved program by the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities.
