



## Medical and Non-Medical Mandatory Requirements for

# Dental Hygiene (DHYG)

## Year 1, 2, 3

Your program requires that you provide proof of the following documentation prior to starting any of your program's lab/clinical components. Please connect with your Placement Coordinator if you have any questions.

### Please note...

- All requirements must remain current/up to date throughout the duration of your labs/clinical experience.
- Original documents will be required for uploading to a third-party provider for verification.
- Typical deadline date to attain /provide these documents for your program is September 30<sup>th</sup> for 1<sup>st</sup> year / early August for 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> years.

### Year 1 Requirements

- Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis (adult dose on or after 18<sup>th</sup> birthday)
- Measles Mumps Rubella (2 doses of vaccine or proof of immunity)
- Hepatitis B (documentation regarding immunity status)
- Varicella (vaccine or documentation of immunity status)
- Tuberculosis Screening (documentation of 2-step mantoux skin test, subsequent 1-step – required annually)
- Polio (vaccine or documentation of immunity status)
- Influenza vaccine (obtained annually when vaccination becomes available)
- COVID-19 Immunization

### Non-medical Requirements

- CPR (Level C – required to renew every 3 years)
- Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector Screening (required annually)



# Program Requirements

- Mask Fit (Valid for 2 years specific type required for program)
- WHMIS Training (required to be renewed every 3 years)
- Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Certificate (AODA)
- Worker Health and Safety Awareness in 4 Steps (Bill 18)
