



Medical and Non-Medical Mandatory Requirements for

Medical Laboratory Assistant (MDLA)

Year 1

Your program requires that you provide proof of the following documentation prior to starting your programs lab/clinical components. Please connect with your Placement Coordinator if you have any questions.

Please note...

- All requirements must remain current/up to date throughout the duration of your labs/clinical experience.
- Original documents will be required for uploading to a third-party provider for verification.
- Typical deadline date to attain/provide these documents for your program is September 30th.

Medical Requirements

- Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis (adult dose on or after 18th birthday)
- Measles Mumps Rubella (2 doses of vaccine or proof of immunity)
- Varicella (vaccine or documentation of immunity status)
- Polio (vaccine or documentation of immunity status)
- Hepatitis B (documentation regarding immunity status)
- Tuberculosis Screening (documentation of 2-step mantoux skin test – valid for 1 year)
- Influenza vaccine (obtained annually when vaccination becomes available)
- COVID-19 Immunization



Non-Medical Requirements

- Respiratory Mask Fitting N95-3M models (valid for 2 years)
- Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector Screening (valid for 1 year)
- WHMIS Training (Valid for 3 years)
- Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Certificate (AODA)
- Worker Health and Safety Awareness in 4 Steps (Bill 18)
