



Medical and Non-Medical Mandatory Requirements for

Occupational Therapy Assistant / Physiotherapy Assistant (OTPA)

Year 1, 2

Your program requires that you provide proof of the following documentation prior to starting any of your program's clinical components. Please connect with your Placement Coordinator if you have any questions.

Please note...

- All requirements must remain current/up to date throughout the duration of your clinical experience.
- Original documents will be required for uploading to a third-party provider for verification.
- Typical deadline date to attain/provide these documents for your program is the end of July before the start of your 2nd year.

Medical Requirements

- Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis (adult dose on or after 18th birthday)
- Measles Mumps Rubella (2 doses of vaccine or proof of immunity)
- Hepatitis B (documentation regarding immunity status)
- Varicella (vaccine or documentation of immunity status)
- Tuberculosis Screening (documentation of 2-step mantoux skin test, subsequent 1-step)
- Influenza vaccine (obtained annually when vaccination becomes available)
- COVID-19 Immunization

Non-medical Requirements

- Standard First Aid (valid for 3 years)
- CPR Level BLS/ HCP (valid for 1 year)



Program Requirements

- WHMIS Training (Valid for 3 years)
- Respiratory Mask Fitting N95-3M models (required to renew every 2 years)
- Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector Screening (required annually)
- Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Certificate (AODA)
- Worker Health and Safety Awareness in 4 Steps (Bill 18)
